

Azienda Agricola Dal Bello

"Love for wine and where it comes from" this is the wine making philosophy of the Dal Bello's family. Born from the passion, the winery was founded in the mid-fifties by Vittorio Dal Bello who has passed on his passion for this work and for his homeland, the picturesque and greenish Asolani hills.

The company is located on the hills of one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, Asolo, in the province of Treviso, 200 meters above sea level. The mild climate and the perfect altitude makes this genoreous land the perfect place to create excellent and elegant wines, both white and red, and now even Rosé.

Thanks to its delightful climate and superb location, Asolo was populated since prehistoric times. In Roman times "Acelum", as Asolo was designed by the Romans, developed mainly

between the first century B.C. and the first century A.D. At different times between, Asolo was under the hegemony of different powerful families, Tempesta, Ezzelini, Scaligeri, Carraresi. In 1489 Venezia bestowed upon Caterina Cornaro, former Queen of Cyprus, the Seigniory of Asolo. Caterina Cornaro created a magnificent Renaissance court of artists, men of letters and poets and left an indelible cultural imprint. It is just in 1489 that Dal bello family started his history in Asolo.



In this generous land in Veneto region, rich in culture, the company extends its own vineyards along five Medieval villages, for a total of 30 hectares. Facing south, the vineyards are exposed to the sun all day, ideal to express at the most its characteristics. The limited production per hectare gives the wine an increase of the structural and aromatic component, making particularly intense taste and fragrance.
